Don't Quit

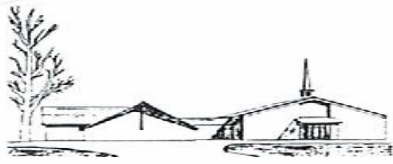
When things go wrong as they sometimes will,


